

## PANVET 2024 –

### INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE PRESENTATION OF ABSTRACTS AS ORAL PRESENTATIONS OR POSTERS

- ✓ Abstracts will be sent exclusively through a form found in the following link <https://www.panvet2024.uy/>
- ✓ Papers involving projects or research results, teaching and extension experiences, case studies and theoretical contributions in all areas of the veterinary sciences.
- ✓ The abstract may be written in Spanish, Portuguese or French. **An abstract in English must be attached.**
- ✓ The text must be presented in Open Office (.odt) or Word (.doc) version 6 or later versions. Up to 3 bibliographic citations will be allowed, according to APA rules (seventh edition).
- ✓ Page size A4, with 3cm margins (right, left, top and bottom)
- ✓ Title: Font size 12, Bold, Times New Roman, and Centred.
- ✓ The title must be written in Spanish, Portuguese or French, and also in English.
- ✓ Authors names should be included immediately after the title in Times New Roman 10, bold and centred.
- ✓ The email addresses of the authors that will present the paper and affiliations should be included below the authors' names in Times New Roman 10, italics.
- ✓ The abstract will be presented in Spanish, Portuguese, or French with a maximum of 500 words and must mention the most important aspects of the research. Regarding the presentation of investigation results particular attention is needed to the theoretical and methodological foundations, experimental design, results, and conclusions. Concerning the clinical cases, projects, description of teaching and extension experiences, and theoretical and methodological contributions, attention should be given to the description of findings and implementation.
- ✓ The body of the text must not have indentations or tabs, Times New Roman font, size 11, with single spacing.
- ✓ Keywords: a maximum of three keywords, should be written in the language of the abstract and in English below the text. Keywords must describe the content of the work and must be written in lowercase letters and separated by semicolons.
- ✓ Abstracts need to be submitted by the deadline of **Friday 31 May 2024**.
- ✓ The Scientific Committee will evaluate the works as they are received.
- ✓ Abstracts will be published in a special edition of the Veterinary Journal of Uruguay <https://www.revistasmvu.com.uy/index.php/smvu>
